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ICAPP's Certificate Course aims to facilitate the professional development of psychologists, psychiatrists, social workers, counsellors, welfare workers, teachers and others who wish to develop their capacity to work more effectively with children, adolescents and families. It provides a psychoanalytic framework and helps professionals to develop their observational and thinking skills. The course will aim to foster greater conceptual understanding and emotional depth when engaging in professional work.

In 2017 we are offering a Certificate Course, comprising an Infant Observation seminar and two reading seminars. It is also possible to enrol in individual seminars: the reading seminars are 6-months units, and Infant Observation is offered only as a full year seminar.

CERTIFICATE COURSE in PSYCHOANALYTIC WORK WITH CHILDREN, ADOLESCENTS & FAMILIES

2017 Course Outline

Infant Observation (Full Year)

This course can be taken as a stand-alone course. It is a 1-year course designed to help anyone working in any capacity with children, adolescents and their families. It is also the core course for those who are interested in becoming psychotherapists.

Infant Observation is an intense experience in which the student learns directly about very young states of mind. Students are required to present detailed written descriptions of weekly observations of an infant at home interacting with their caretaker. These observations are then discussed in a small group with an experienced seminar leader. The aim is to develop skills in detailed observation, disciplined describing, learning how to establish observer boundaries, exploring the conscious and unconscious meanings of behaviour, and thinking about the growth of the mind and personality. To integrate and complete the course, students submit a 5000 word paper at the completion of the observation.

Introduction to Psychoanalytic Concepts and Practice (Semester 1)

This is a 6 month (15 week) reading seminar over Terms 1 & 2. It is available as a stand alone course or as part of the Certificate Course. The aim of this seminar is to introduce students to key concepts in Psychoanalytic theory, starting from Freud and covering theoretical developments up to the present day. The reading will examine the major theoretical concepts as well as exploring how these concepts can be applied to the clinical situation.

Introduction to the History and Practice of Child & Adolescent Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy (Semester 2)

This is a 6 month (15 week) reading seminar taken over Terms 3 & 4. It is available as a stand alone course or as part of the Certificate Course. This course is unique to ICAPP and provides both a historical overview of the development of psychoanalytic work with children and adolescents, as well as studying the practicalities of working psychoanalytically with children, adolescents and families.

Certificate Course:

The Certificate Course comprises the Infant Observation seminar and the two reading seminars. Completion of the course includes a compulsory 5000 word essay for Infant Observation, and 1500 word essays for each of the reading seminars.

Individual Seminars:

It is possible to enrol in individual seminars as stand-alone units. It is not compulsory for students enrolled in the individual seminars to submit the essay, however it is encouraged as preparation of the essay assists in the learning process.
